## Australian showcase for European investors

**Building on the success of four years of AusBiotech investment showcase events in North America, AusBiotech has announced it will lead an investment business mission of Australian life sciences companies to present to and meet with European investors.**

AusBiotech Investment's mission will present the Australian Showcase: Amsterdam 2011 on October 7, followed by attendance at BioPartnering Europe in London from October 9-11.

The Australian Showcase event in Europe will use AusBiotech Investment's tried and true, short-pitch formula to give European investors an overview of up to 20 of Australia's top biotechnology companies with products in the clinic or identified opportunities.
