AusBiotech's Australasian Life Sciences Investment Summit 2010

AusBiotech announces its second annual *Australasian Life Sciences Investment Summit*, to be held in Melbourne, Victoria on 19 October 2010. The invitation-only event, which will again be held ahead of *AusBiotech 2010*, is the premier life science investment conference for Australia and the Asia-Pacific region and aims to showcase the high calibre of investment potential in Australia's biotechnology industry to international investors.
