## **NEW SOUTH WALES GOVERNMENT, AUSBIOTECH**

The New South Wales Government will subsidize eligible companies by \$1,500 to exhibit at the Ausbiotech conference in Melbourne in October 2010.

An Ausbiotech media release said that to be eligible to receive funding, organizations must be incorporated in New South Wales and/or have the majority of their workforce in the State; have fewer than 200 employees; have less than \$30 million in turnover; have been in operation for at least one year; and be able to deliver a product.

Ausbiotech said the cost per exhibitor would be the subsidized amount of \$4,000 to exhibit on the NSW stand at the Ausbiotech conference, instead of the full cost of \$5,500.

The media release said participants would be liable for all other costs.
